MEDPRO explores the challenges the countries in the South Mediterranean region, from Morocco to Turkey, will have to cope with in the next decades. The project will undertake a foresight analysis to consider the interactions between development and Euro-Mediterranean cooperation in the fields of **geopolitics**; **demography**; **education**; **social protection**; **energy**; **climate change**; **trade and finance**. The outcome of this exercise will be to provide the best scientific underpinning for future policy decisions to be taken at both domestic and EU levels within the European Neighbourhood Policy (ENP) and Union for the Mediterranean frameworks (UfM).

MEDPRO region: Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestinian Authority, Syria and Tunisia (with a population of 190M) and Turkey (with a population of 70M)


